PLAN NOW FOR SPRING AND SUMMER HOME IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS

EXTERIOR CHANGES NEED HOA APPROVAL: If you are considering making exterior improvements to your home, the HOA Covenants require written approval for most projects. <u>Project requests must be submitted at least 30 days in advance to ensure approval is obtained prior to commencement of work or signing of a work contract.</u>

Exterior changes include, but are not limited to:

- Fences Decks Porches Sheds Siding Gates
- Landscaping Changes Solar Panels Structural additions
- Decks/Patios A/C Heat Pump Solar Panels Hot Tubs

Exterior changes to the following IF THEY DIFFER in design, color or materials from original:

- Doors and windows - Exterior Paint - Roofing - Garage Door

Please do not disregard the requirement for approval prior to initiation.

NEW BOARD MEMBERS SOUGHT

We are actively seeking at least one new person to fill a vacancy on the Board. To be a Board member you must be the legal owner of a property in Noble Park, and have a keen interest in the wellbeing and future of your community.

The Board is the governing body of the HOA and is responsible for administering and enforcing the covenants, rules and regulations necessary to govern the Association. Members review requests for property and landscape improvements or changes and perform other duties as required.

NEW TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD? THINGS TO KNOW

Here's the "hit list" of Covenant requirements that everyone should know for every day consideration:

- Trailers, Campers, Work/Commercial Vehicles, Storage PODs are not allowed in driveways or parked on the street in the neighborhood, and must be parked outside of Noble Park.
- Vehicle Maintenance/Repair may only be performed in the garage.
- Trash/Compost/Recycle Bins are not permitted to be put out for pick up before <u>Wednesday</u> evening, and must be returned to the garage or out of sight by Thursday night.
- Short Term Rentals (Airbnb, VRBO, Etc.): Transient, short term or similar rentals in Noble Park are strictly prohibited.
- **Garage Doors:** Please keep garage doors closed during the day and evening. This is required by the Covenants and is a safety and security issue.
- Exterior Lights: We hope everyone will contribute to the increased safety and security of the neighborhood by leaving exterior lights (porch and/or garage) ON overnight.
- PETS: Please be respectful.
 - o **Animal** Waste: Do not use your neighbors' yards as bathrooms for your pets. If it is unavoidable then **clean up the mess**.
 - o Cats: The Covenants prohibit an owner from allowing <u>any</u> pet to run at large, requiring all pets to be under the owner's control. Please keep your cat(s) in your house and yard.
